

Pioneer, Japan

Japan is a rare country in the 10/40 Window because of its freedom of religion, even for foreign missionaries. With that said, Japan's evangelical population is merely 0.5%, and the leadership within Japan's church is aging out with few younger leaders rising up to take the baton for the future. As a Pioneer, you will serve a critical role in SRC's work to see our vision become reality in Japan, 'Gospel Access for Everyone'.

JOB DESCRIPTION: A Pioneer is responsible for entering a new SRC mission field without any pre-existing ministries on the ground. They work with SRC's President to examine the spiritual landscape, identify SRC's location starting point, and then develops and implements the entry plan for SRC. As the entry develops, the Pioneer then identifies where additional workers are needed, the type of workers needed, and develops working relationships with local and national churches for long-term partnership.
